# ORIGIN AND GROWTH OF THE ASSOCIATION OF ENGINEERS

A.D. 1918. Old boys of Sibpore Engineering College (now known as B. E. College) have come to attend the annual Reunion. Reunion meeting was over and dinner was scheduled at 8 p.m. So, the interval of gay evening was opportune for an informal gettogether in the spacious greens of the beloved Gossip, tittle-tattle, chat, pleasant college. retrospection of good old days, reminiscence of chums and teachers, marked the occasion. In one such groups, someone became rather serious or constructive and proposed that they should meet on many more occasions in such atmosphere, to have happy time out of work. He was none other than Jatindranath Banerjee and his proposal received spontaneous applause. Not in mere words but in actions too-Chandrakanta Ghosh at once invited all present to his house (10 Rammohan Roy Road) the next week end, to work out the idea. They met, talked subsequent weekend also. Number of promoters swelled and financial solvency was attained from donations. A spatial flat in the second floor was rented in Mirjapur Street (now Surjya Sen Street) near college square.

There were regular gatherings in this flat. One evening Narendra Kumar Bhattacherjee, Asstt. Chief Electrical Inspector to the Govt. of Bengal, who was an Associate member of the Institution of Electrical Engineers, England, proposed that their organisational set up should be on the same lines as the British Institution but the term "Institution" should be replaced by "Association". The proposal was heralded unanimously and immediately a committee was

formed with Narendra Kumar Bhattacherjee as chairman and Chandrakanta Ghosh, Jatindranath Banerjee, R. K. Ganguly, Jogeshchandra Ganguly and few others as members. They drafted the memorandum and formed committee.

The plenipotentiary committee consisted of Satishchandra Mitra, Chief Engineer, Calcutta Corporation as chairman; Sureshchandra Sanyal, District Engineer, Calcutta Corporation as secretary; Jogeshchandra Ganguly, Asstt. Engineer, Braithwaite Co. as assistant secretary; Jatindranath Banerjee, Building Surveyor, Calcutta Corporation as treasurer. Satishchandra Mitra could not serve long. So, Dr. S. K. Dutta on his return from Germany, took over. He was asthe first President of the Association. Dr. Dutta was a teacher in Sibpore College prior to his departure for Germany. With his experience abroad, he started with full vigour to put the Association on sound footing, but his untimely death was a blow to the Association. His place was taken by Prof. B. C. Gupta, Head of the electrical engineering department of Sibpore Engineering College and the only Indian Professor. At his instance, engineers from Sibpore College joined in large numbers. In those days Sibpore Engineering College was the solitary institution in Burma, Assam, Bihar, Orissa, Madhyapradesh, Nepal and Calcutta University was the only University.

Sibpore engineers were joined by another group of engineers who studied engineering in U. K. and were mostly graduates of Glasgow.

They were frustrated to find that foreigners with much inferior qualifications could vie with them and secure job and with comparatively higher foreign qualifications, they were vanquished in the struggle for existence. They joined the Sibpore engineers to make the Association a strong forum and pioneers of the Association are engineers from Sibpore and Glasgow.

A. D. 1919. It was fourteen years after the movement for unsettling the partition of Bengal and two years ahead of national awakening, throbbing for struggle for emancipation. Like others, Indian engineers were also victims of differential treatment in the hands of foreign administration. Industry was in the hands of foreigners who imported covenanted hands from home. Less qualified people, from abroad and particular community in India, could get a job in foreign concern or even in Government department, in prefrence to qualified Indian engineers. Railways were run by private companies incorporated in England. There were two grades for same responsibility—one for Indian and one for Anglo-Indian and European. Even in the amenities in public utility concern, therewere discrimination. There was "European third class" with first class amenities and third class fare. In Government service, if an Indian could rise as the chief engineer, it was deemed Silhoutted against such enan exception. vironment, qualified young engineers found enough grouse to organise themselves to fight it out.

The constitution of the Association was drawn up on the same lines as the Institution of Civil Engineers, the oldest institution in the It was named the "Association of Engineers (Bengal)". The main objects were: (1) safeguarding and promoting the status of engineers; (2) research for development of • engineering; (3) dissemination of engineering

The activities of young Indian engineers did not escape the eyes of alien rulers. engineers in this country were up in their loins to form an institution of their own. not deviate from the policy of 'divide et imand could successfully rope in Sir Rajendra Mukherjee of Martin & Co., though he had no engineering degree. Attempts were made to foil the British design by impressing on Sir Rajendra Mukherjee to dissociate himself, from the British move and work for the Association of Engineers. He did not yield to requests. So, the Association had to struggle In one of their from the very inception. meetings, the British President of the Institution of Engineers, made some offending remarks about Indian Engineers and as a protest, many self-respecting Indian engineers severed their connection; under the leadership of Rai Bahadur Girish Chandra Das, Chief Engineer, Martin & Co., who worked till the last day of his life for the Association of Engineers.

With the expansion of sphere of activities, became provinces from, other members of the Association. It was, at this stage, considered prudent to give the Association an All-India character, by deleting the suffix "Bengal" and registering it under the Societies Act as "Association of Engineers". The seed planted in the green lawn of Sibpore College, thus developed to a small plant. Sri Suresh Chandra Sanyal was the first secretary and Sri Jogesh Chandra Ganguli was the first editor. Sri Jogesh Chandra Banerjee, the Vice President, got the Association affiliated to the Bengal National Chamber of Commerce and Industry. In the year 1932, the Association applied to the Corporation of Calcutta for 13 cottas of land for construction of museum, library and night school. In the year 1934, syllabus

for examination of candidates for membership for examination of various grades was prepared. The Associaof various g. and Association representative Rai Bahadur Girish Chandra Das was connected with engineering faculty of the Calcutta University. Professor the Canding of Mollegan College, Lahore initiated the compilation of engineering terms in Bengali and these were published regularly in the Assoand the Asso-ciation Journal. The 'Paribhasha Samsad' of the West Bengal Government sought assistance of the association regarding compilation of technical terms and these were duly complied with. Among the vanguards of the Association, the names of Rai Bahadur Girish Chandra Das, Rai Bahadur Amarnath Das, Dr. B. N. De, S. N. Ghosh, Jiten Das Gupta, P. C. Bose, Sachin Bandopadhyay, Haren Banerjee, Kalidas Roy, Nagendranath Sen, Dr. J. N. Basu, Amulya Sen will remain writeen in letters of gold for their sincere effort to advance the cause of, the Association.

The Silver Jubilee was celebrated with one pomp.

In the year 1949, an application • was submitted to the Government of India for award of charter to which the Govt. made a counter proposal for merging with the Institution of Engineers. This proposal was discarded though there were many Government service holders in the Association. The application form of the Institution of Engineers contained a clause "When did you arrive in India", which implies, beyond doubt that the Institution of Engineers is foreign-based and owes allegiance to England. Members of our Association could not accept a proposal deregatory to the self respect of Indians. The Association did not get a charter and could not enroll students in thousands. Neither its membership could be used as a pasport for securing Government jobs. Inspite of this the Association has lived for fifty years.

In the year, 1962, some interpalletions were

made during the budget session, regarding the recognition of the oldest India-based organisation. Sri Humayun Kabir, replied on behalf of the Government that request for recognition "has not been accepted so far". How far is "so far" is now the question to be reckoned. Of course, Sri Kabir indicated out of Loksabha that the obstacle for recognition was coming from another institution which wants monopoly in the matter. There were comments in Ananda Bazar Patrika, Jugantar, Swadhinata and other papers for Govt. recognition.

In the year 1963, two representatives of the Association met Sri P. C. Sen, Chief Minister of West Bengal on the 10th August. Verbal assurance of grant for Library was given by the chief minister but nothing was forthcoming. Of course, the education ministry at the centre, encouraged us for continuation of activities for "promotion of engineering knowledge and engineering profession". In 1963, the foreign ministry requested for sending delegate to the Afro-Asia housing congress at Ciaro and delegate of the Association of Engineers attended the Cairo congress. Observer was sent to the British fair. A delegate was nominated to the International conference in Japan. These are illustrations to show Govt. recognition.

In the year 1968, the Association took the initiative for convening the first All India Engineers' Conference. The Joint Council of professional engineering bodies also owes its existence at the initiative of the Association.

Fifty years may appear too long a period but in the march of time, 50 years is not a long stride to achieve total success. Our relentless struggle will continue, with the sympathy of our people.

We celebrate the Golden Jubillee now and would hope for the centenary celebration with greater achievement, more eclat.

# MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

- 1. The name of the Association is "The Association of Engineers."
- 2. The Registered Office of the Association will, for the present, be located at 24, Netaji Subhas Road, Calcutta-1. The registration number, under Act XXI of 1860, is 4998 of 1924.
  - 3. The objects with which the Association has been formed are :-
- I. To improve the status and forward the interests of Engineers and the profession of Engineering generally and particularly of the members of this Association.
- II. To promote the general advancement of the science of Engineering and allied subjects and facilitate the exchange of information and ideas on these subjects amongst the members of the Association and for this purpose:—
- (i) To hold meetings for reading and discussing papers bearing on Engineering or allied subjects.
- (ii) To print, publish, sell and distribute the proceedings and reports of the Association or any papers, communications, works or treatises on Engineering or allied subjects in English or other language or any abstracts thereof or extracts therefrom.
- (iii) To establish an Engineering Library and take charge of books, pamphlets, publications and manuscripts, etc., of the Library of the Association.
- III. To create an atmosphere of Engineering culture and to promote inventions and researches in Engineering or allied subjects by making grants of money, books or apparatus and in other ways.
- IV. To co-operate with other Engineering Associations or Institutions of this or other countries whose objects are similar to those of this Association.
  - V. To purchase, take on lease or otherwise

- acquire and also let on lease or otherwise dispose of any premises or other property for the purpose of the Association subject to the provisions of the rules and of Government of India Acts regulating registered Associations.
- VI. To establish a Rest house for members who do not reside in Calcutta but may come here for private purposes or for the purpose of the Association requiring a short stay.
- VII. To organise an employment bureau, keep in touch with the employers and the members of the Association and thus to help the employers in quickly securing suitable men and to assist any member who may, for the time being, be in need of employment.
- VIII. To collect, tabulate, print and sell or distribute information helpful for the promotion and improvement of industry and to help the industries of the country with technical advice, etc.
- IX. To promote social intercourse among Engineers and Technologists.
- X. To co-operate with Engineering Institutions, Railways, District Boards, Municipalities, Mining Boards, Govt. departments, Planning Organisations.
- XI. To provide indoor games and common room for recreation.
- XII. To do such other lawful things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

### ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

(AS AMENDED UP TO MARCH, 1969)

### **PRELIMINARY**

- 1. The Membership of the Association shall be unlimited.
- 2. These Articles of the Association shall come into force from the 1st March, 1921, and shall continue to remain in force untill they are modified by a resolution of a General Meeting of the Association after duly notifying such to every member and fully considering their views.
- 3. The Association may have Honorary Members and shall have Members and Associate Members who shall be known as Corporate Members and Associates, Graduates and Students who shall be known as non-Corporate Members. It may also have Patrons and Donors and Technical Corporate Members.
- 4. The Members of the different classes already existing as it is on the 1st March, 1921, and such other persons as shall be admitted, in accordance with the Articles, and none others, shall be or become Members of the Association (either as Honorary Members, Members, Associate Members, Associate Members, Associates, Graduates or Students or Technical Corporate Members as the case may be) and be entered on the Register as such.
- 5. The rights and privileges of every member of any class shall be personal to himself, and shall not be transferable or transmissible by his own act or by operation of law.
- 6. No Honorary Member, Associate Member, Associate, Graduate or Student shall

by reason of being legally a member of the Association be entitled to any privileges other than those which by the Articles, attach to the specific class of members of the Association to which he orlongs, and whereever the term "Member" is herein used without qualification, it shall be taken to exclude Honorary Members, Associate Members, Associates, Graduates, Students and Technical Corporate Members.

7. The Association may admit such other persons and organisation as may be hereafter qualified and elected in that behalf as Honorary Members, Members, Associate Members, Associates, Graduates, Students and Technical Corporate Members respectively.

#### **DONORS**

Any person who may take an interest in the Association and make a donation to the funds of the Association a sum of Rs. 100/- or more, may on the recommendation of the Council, be elected a Donor of the Association at a General Meeting; such election may be for life or for a definite term.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

The authorised abbreviations indicating the class in the Associations to which any person belongs shall be as follows:—

No person or organisation shall adopt or describe himself by any other abbreviation to indicate the class to which he belongs than that provided in this article.

#### DIPLOMAS

Subject to such regulations and on payment of such fees as the Council may from time to time prescribe, the Council may issue to any member of any class (except students) a certificate showing the class to which he belongs. Every such certificate shall remain the property of, and shall, on demand be returned to the Association.

### HONORARY MEMBERS ...

Any Engineer who, in the opinion of the Council, is of eminent position and attainments and whom the Association specially desires to honour for exceptionally important services in connection therewith may be elected as an Honorary Member.

#### **MEMBERS**

Every candidate for election or transfer to the class of Member shall satisfy the Council:—

- (i) That he is not less than 35 years of age.
- (ii) That he is engaged in the profession of engineering in a position of high responsibility, or has retired from this profession after having held a position of high responsibility.
- and (iii) That he has at least one of the following qualifications:—

- (b) Or, he has had adequate education and training in Engineering and has had experience involving responsibility for at least ten years out of which five years has been in a position of superior responsibility and distinction.
  - (c) Or, he is a member of an engineering Institution or Society membership of which, in the opinion of the Council, is proof of suitable technical qualifications and experience.
- (d) Or, he is a person of eminence in the profession of engineering.

Note:—In considering the qualifications of candidates, responsible charge in engineering teaching and on research may be regarded as position of superior responsibility.

### ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Every candidate for election or transfer to the class of Associate Members shall satisfy the Council:—

- (a) That he is not less then 25 years of age.
- (b) That he has passed the examination for Associate Membership prescribed by the Council or has been exempted from the examination having passed such other examination or examinations which are recognised by the Council as equivalent to their own examination, Vide rule 7 of the Rules and syllabus for examination.
- (c) That he has engineering training and practice for not less then five years out of which at least one year has been spent in a position of responsibility.

### TECHNICAL CORPORATE MEMBER

Technical Corporate Member shall be a registered commercial or industrial undertaking, a Department of the Central or State Government, a local body, an institution, a recognised statutory body or a company/firm interested in the development of Engineering activities. Technical Corporate Members shall enjoy all the privileges of Members and Associate Members excepting that they will not have voting rights. The annual subscription for the Technical Corporate Membership shall be Rs. 200/-

#### **ASSOCIATES**

Every candidate for election to the class of Associates shall satisfy the Council:—

- (a) That he is not less than 35 years of age.
- (b) That though not an engineer by profession he has attained a position in a special pursuit allied to engineering as would further the cause of engineering knowledge and practice.

### **GRADUATES**

Every candidate for election or transfer to the class of Graduates shall satisfy the Council:—

- (a) That he is not less than 21 years of age.
- and (b) That he has graduated from an Engineering College or University or Institution recognised by the Council or has passed the A & B Section of the examination of the Association or an equivalent examination recognised by the Council, vide rule 6 of the Rules and Syllabus for examination.

### STUDENTS

Every candidate for election to the class of Students shall satisfy the Council:—

(a) That he is not less than 18 years of age.

and (b) That he is or has been a student of engineering at one of the Universities, Colleges or Schools recognised by the Council.

Or, That he is or has been an engineering pupil, apprentice or assistant under the supervision of a Corporate Member or any engineer recognised by the Council and has passed the preliminary Examination of the Association or equivalent examinations recognised by the Council, vide rule 5 of the Rules and Syllabus for examination.

Every student shall be entitled to remain in the class of students during the pleasure of the Council, but in no case beyond the 30th day of June next following the day on which he attains the age of 26.

### ELECTION OF NEW MEMBERS

Honorary Members shall be elected by the Association on the recommendation of the Council.

Members of all classes (except Honorary Members) shall be elected at the ordinary meeting of the Council by the Corporate Members present, and the election shall be by ballot. The proportion of votes necessary for the election of any candidate shall be at least two-thirds of the total number of votes given and such election shall be announced at the next meeting of the Association and published in the Bulletin of the Association.

Candidates for election shall be proposed and supported as provided hereunder, from personal knowledge and in writing, according to a form approved by the Council:—

- (a) Any person desirous of election as a Member, Associate Member or Associate shall be proposed by one Corporate Member and supported by three Corporate Members;
- (b) Any person desirous of election as a Graduate shall be proposed by one Corporate

Member and supported by one Corporate Member;

(c) Any person desirous of election as a Student shall be proposed by one Corporate Member.

For the purposes of this Article any member of any class while serving on the Council shall be deemed to be a member.

In the event of a candidate, residing abroad being unable to obtain the requisite signatures, the signature of the Local Honorary Secretary and of one Corporate Member or alternatively of two Corporate Members, in each case from personal knowledge, shall be sufficient.

## TRANSFER FROM ONE CLASS TO ANOTHER

Candidates for transfer from one class to another shall be proposed and supported in the manner prescribed in Articles 19, 20 and 21 for election to the respective class to which the candidates are desirous of being transferred.

# TO THE FUTURE ARCHITECTS OF INDIA\*

K. N. Mookerjee, M. Sc.

Chairman, Finance Corporation

I am conscious, I am speaking today, mostly of young engineers or would be engineers. These young men in particular have a lot to complain about. After all, they have taken time and expensive training and education. If they have to move from door to door in search of job like another unemployed, then surely there is something wrong with our economy and society at large. Engineers after all, are the main instruments of industrial progress. In fact, we cannot conceive of an industrial society without engineers.

Engineers had to play a vital role in managing and co-ordinating big industrial complexes that were growing over the country. Humainty at various stages of its evolution had been led by philosophers, economists and scientists. But moderntimes, belong to engineers, who will have to lead to a greater progress.

Bearing these facts in mind, I feel distressed that thousands of our young engineers have remained unemployed. It is really a great national tragedy. These young men went to engineering colleges and institutions in the great hope that they would find a worthwhile career after completing their education; also the various plans and blue-prints and projects run by the Government led to such expectations, being raised in the minds of our young men. The failure of our country's planning coupled with two worse and severe drought in the recent past have completely upset our

economic barance, bringing in its strains, stagnation and finally recession, in many vital sectors of the economy. This is the major reason for all our difficulties today, including the unemployment problem amongst the educated youth in the country.

But, having created the mess, we must clear it. When I say, we, I do not mean the government although the government has to play the major role, but all of us, people in every walk of life including the young engineers. Now, one may ask, what one can do to help in the solution of the various national economic problems. In answering this question everybody should find ways of helping himself, since large scale unemployment among the engineers is a major problem for the national economy.

The best way of helping oneself is by finding avenues of self-employment through industries or business ventures. It is no use merely sitting back and asking the government to find jobs for you.

"Tap the talent" is the need of the hour. Young engineers coming out of the colleges need proper guidance. At present we are faced with the problem of finding employment of engineers whose numbers are still between 30,000 to 40,000. The crash programme initiated by the government for unemployed engineers is not likely to provide jobs for more than 3,000 in the Public Sector for the time being. Every year 25,000 engineers and 50,000

diploma-holders would come out of the colleges according to present admission capacity in the country. Can we create enough jobs in Government and other bodies to absorb all the engineers? My answer to it will be 'no'. There was a proposal that every industry should employ 2/3 additional engineers for every erore of production. This may absorb some unemployed engineers for the present. But they will be an additional load for which real jobs do not exist.

According to me, the permanent solution of the problem lies in the engineers becoming self-employed. They should start small and medium industries either individually or collectively.

I have often given thoughts to the problems of engineers' employment and I am convinced that if some of them had tried seriously, they could find opportunity of self-employment in developing economy. They can start small business ventures and industries. If they can think of and plan a sound project, then finance should not be a problem to them. credit pattern of financial institutions all over the country including the West Bengal is being re-oriented to the objective of providing more financial assistance to young technicians and engineers specially those who have good technical know-how, but are unable to start an industry on their own and are also unable to furnish any security against financial assistance, are now being encouraged through a number of special sehemes.

I am also aware that financial assistance to qualified engineers may not be enough in all cases. First of all, they need some idea of how an industry or business enterprise is to be run. I feel, there must be an effective training programme for all those young engineers who wish to start such ventures with financial assistance from the State. Well-planned courses of training for a period of at least six months should be available to such aspiring entrepre-

neurs with proper theoretical instructions in factory layout, production planning, marketing

The creation of an Industrial Assistance Cell-a central agency is very much necessary to assist the entrepreneurs regarding establishment of new industries or difficulties faced by them in the existing industries. It can also disseminate information on procedural formalities, availability of infra-structure facilities or other relevant factors.

While the central agency would guide the young entrepreneurs to locate industries suitable in particular area where there is demand for the unit, they should also be encouraged with other concessions like lower rent for the use and occupation of land and building in Industrial Estates, reduction in electricity charges, exemption of sales tax for a certain period and various other facilities as offered States to attract the entrepreneurs. The concessions offerred will have long range benefit at the cost of immediate reduction in earning and there should be good appeal from the government side to young entrepreneurs as is being done by other States.

Larger flow of funds is also necessary so that young entrepreneurs do not feel handicapped. There are different agencies for such help and I feel here also a central agency is necessary who can take up the cause of entrepreneurs in getting all legitimate requirements of industries covering all stages of production from the stage of purchase of raw materials to the stage of realisation of bills representing the despatch of finished goods. Perhaps the practice obtaining in other countries particularly in Japan is worth emulating.

There are three types of entrepreneurs who go in for Industry: Technician entrepreneurs, dealer entrepreneurs and financial entrepreneurs. Technical entrepreneurs know their job well and can face all the vicissitudes of fortune with adjustments in times of necessity; the

dealer entrepreneur has the command over the market having traded on the items he ultimately resorts to manufacture with notional idea of such techniques. The financial entrepreneur is just to hire technicians to achieve his end. Our experience with the first two groups have been very good having seen their performances.

For young Engineers and Technicians who are leaving university and colleges with degrees in their pockets, with future bleak and dark. as regards prospects for employment, humble advise will be to start any business however small it may be. I have frequently thought over a puzzling problem and never got the correct answer. How is it that the youths of Bengal who gallantly fought and won political freedom are today lagging behind in the fight for economic freedom? They are not lacking in courage and dash in undertaking risk. They braved the bullets bayonets of a colonial power. and faced How is it they are in the background now? For business one needs hard labour, perseverance, courage to undertake risk. All these are in abundance in our youths. The only conclusion that •I draw is that all their efforts are being channalised in a wrong direction. A little orientation will put them on the right path and solve their problem. The people of Madras were considered as backward in business and fit for only white coloured jobs but they have exploded the myth—youths of Bengal can do the same.

Since 1958 only one country with a per capita income of Rs. 5,590/- or more had undergone violent upheavel whereas 87% of the countries with a per capita income of less than Rs. 750/- had sufferred an average of two major outbreaks of violence per country. Therefore, it is clear that at the root of students unrest or political instability lies economic deficiencies.

We have obtained political freedom but the economic freedom is not yet in sight. We are fighting for it. But as in all fights, let the

students community come in the forefront. By fight, I do not mean processions, demonstrations, gherrao or violence in any form. I mean constructive work; let them come forward and and extend a helping hand; work more, produce more, start new industry and trade, solve their own unemployment problem and create jobs for others. This is a herculean job.

'All things seem hard to man that are above his attained, level and they are hard to his unaided effort's but they become at once easy and simple when God in man takes up the challenge.'

The U. S. Under-Secretary of State had once said "Can we graduate fast enough, from the revolution of rising expectation to the evolution of rising responsibility". This is the challenge before our youths.

The economic crisis that we are facing at the present moment is primarily due to the fact that we have not been able to put the youngman in its proper place. I am reminded of a story of a man who was looking at a map of the world. He got disgusted with so many countries and people fighting with each other and disturbing peace of the world. He tore the map into pieces in utter disgust. At that moment his little son appeared and he handed over these pieces of papers to his son and told him "Sonny, can you put this map of the world in order. If you can do that I will take you to the picture to night". He knew that his son would not be able to do it. But he was surprised when after ten minutes his son came back with perfect map in his hand. On further enquiry how he could do it, the son replied "Dady, it is simple; there was a picture of a man on the back of the map and I put the man in its proper place". This is precisely the problem before us.

I had visited Japan many times. I saw Japan immediately after war. People were walking in the streets of Tokyo. Then I saw these people using cycles and then scooters and

motorcycle and now automobiles. This fantastic progress has been made possible within a span of 15 years. So, I asked some of my Japanese friends how this has been made possible and what was the secret of it. My friends replied that only through hard labour.

I had visited West Germany. I had seen Germany immediately after war and I have seen it now with all its prosperity. Such fantastic progress was made possible only within

a period of 10 years. I had asked some of my West German friends about the secret of their success. They said that bombing had destructed their cities, their ports, their factories but it could not destroy their national character. Therefore, two things are necessary for progress and prosperity—one is hard labour and the other is strong national character. Unless we have these two things it is futile to expect an economic miracle in our country.

# Water Supply Problem of Metropolitan Calcutta & Master Plan Recommendation for its Solution

### 1. INTRODUCTION:

Calcutta with its surrounding region was one of the endemic foci of Cholera for a pretty long time. This disease abruptly eruputs especially during the summer, spreads with strange alacrity and plays havoc with human Insanitary environmental : condition and the deterioration of quality and quantity of drinking water accelerate epidemicity and endemicity of asiatic Cholera and other waterborne diseases. In 1884 Dr. Robert Koch had to come from Berlin • down • to Calcutta (at the invitation of British • Government) to investigate into and find out etiological agent for the cause of Cholera. He went even upto Jessore where the scourge of mortality rate from Cholera was then abnormally high. Fortunately, he was able after culture to isolate under his microscope the germ of Cholera-comma bacilli, i.e Cholera vibriofrom the stool of the cholera infected person. His hypothesis stood the test of time.

After the incidence of epidemic cholera of 1958 in Calcutta Govt. was able to make WHO interested in the study for eradication of cholera from this area which remained an endemic focus of spread of this disease throughout the world. WHO Team under the leadership of Prof. Abel Wolman made an interim recommendation in early part of 1960.

On the recommendation of WHO Expert

Team WHO set up a Consulting Engineering Consortium to examine the problem and to prepare a Master Plan for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage of Metropolitan Calcutta supported by a team of Indian Engineers. They framed status report for water supply, sewerage & drainage condition of Metropolitan Calcutta at the very outset.

In order to plan for more water in this vast area of Calcutta Metropolitan District, various complexities of problems are to be dealt with. It is necessary to determine the existing facilities, to assess the existing and future demands (domestic, industrial, fire, municipal and others) in stages and to devise ways and means to solve the problem by exploring more secured sources of water supply and extending the distribution system throughout the length and breadth of CMD for equitable distribution of protected water after treating the water properly.

#### 2. LOCATION:

Calcutta Metropolitan District situated on the both sides of the rives Bhagirathi (Hooghly) covers nearly 490 square miles and brings under its compass 3 Corporations (Calcutta, Howrah and Chandernagar), 33 Municipalities, 33 non-municipal urban areas, and considerable extent of adjacent rural fringes likely to be urbanised soon.

#### 3. EXISTING PACILITIES:

The details of the existing facilities as to its sources of water supply, present treatment facilities, arrangement of transmission main and the major and minor distribution system, for conveyance of water to consumers' places its nature and capacities of storage facilities and pumping arrangements were determined which were found to be very inadequate.

Calcutta, Hooghly-Chinsura, Howrah, Scrampore, Baranagar-Kamarhati and Uttarpara only receive water from the river Bhagirathi whereas the remaining municipalities take recourse to underground source of water supply. In emergency water supply scheme all municipal areas within CMD is provided with protected water supply. Works for the non-municipal urban areas are in progress for piped water supply.

#### 4. WATER DEMAND:

#### Domestic Demand

In order to assess the domestic demand for Calcutta Metropolitan District (CMD) is divided into two categories of consumers for domestic purpose:

- i) Gpoup I: Occupiers of holdings having a variety of plumbing fixtures.

  This group will consume 50 gpcd (60 gpcd for Calcutta and Howrah).
- ii) Group II: Occupiers of dwelling containing a minimum number of plumbing fixtures having one tap and latrine to each building and where the residents depend on community roaddide water taps. They consume 20 gpcd on an average.

On the basis of the projected 1981 and 2001 population average daily domestic water demand has been framed by population zones

which comes to 411.57, mgd in 1981 and 753.82 mgd in 2001 A.D.

#### 5. INDUSTRIAL REQUIREMENTS:

to the following four consolidated groups:
(1) Engineering, (Metal Industries) (2)
Chemical, (3) Jute and textile, (4) others
and tentatively assessed their requirements.
The industrial demand assessed as 231.0 mgd and 426.3 mgd in 1981 and 2001 respectively.

#### 6. FIRE ALLOWANCES:

Fifty per cent of the total demand for fire services will be obtained from municipal supplies. The balance is obtained from tanks, ponds, khals and rivers. Fire supply will be available at the rate of 2,500 gpm to 500 gpm i. e. from highly industrial district to lesser residential areas simultaneously with maximum—day domestic demand plus average-day industrial demand at a minimum residual hydrant pressure of 20 psi.

#### 7. DESIGN CRITERIA:

#### A. Pressure:

Minimum pressure at service conection =20 psi.

Minimum pressure in primary distribution mains=35 psi.

Maximum pressure in primary distribution mains=90 psi.

#### B. Peak Flowe:

Maximum day demand is taken as 1.25 of average day demand.

Maximum hourly demand has been adopted as 1.6 to 2.0 (mean value of 1.85) times of average day.

C. 'C' values adopted for different pipes in Hazen Formula:

For existing pipes for filtered and unfiltered

water having various diameter. 'C' value ranges between 50 to 90 depending upon the diameters of the conduits.

For new pipes—
24" inch diameter and above=130
(Assumed cement lined)
16 to 20 inch diameter=120 (Assumed cement lined)
Below 16" diameter=110 (not lined)

#### D. Design Period:

The following table will indicate the design period adopted for different components of water supply system.

#### 6. POPULATION:

The population of CMD is divided into 10 zones, having a total population of 6.537 millions in 1961. It is estimated that in 1981 it will be 9.879 millions and is expected to reach 14.788 millions during 2001 A.D. The population zonal division is an arbitrary one based primarily on study of—

- (a) Industrial employment by different industrial categories;
- (b) Income generated in different sections of economy;
- (c) Present population density.

Four of the 10 zones are located on the western bank of Hooghly whereas 6 on the eastern side.

#### 7. DETAILS OF WATER SUPPLY:

This subject can be elaborated in under different captions. The first of all comes source of water-supply within the CMD area, its treatment facilities both for surface and ground-water supplies, its transmission main from treatment site to distribution centre, its storage facilities, pumping stations and then the net work of distribution system from which water is conveyed to individual premises.

#### 8. SOURCE:

There are three probable sources of water supply for C.M.D. The 'Bhagirathi', Damodar and Ajoy' and ground water. At present none of the sources are secured and dependable. The construction of Farrakka Barrage which will divert at least 20,000 cfs of headwater from the river Ganga into Bhagirathi during dry weather period is deemed as dependable source. The Damodar-Ajoy does not carry sufficient water during dry season to meet the need. The quality of ground water in southern half of C.M.D. is far from uniformly satisfactory having undesirable salinity and iron contents.

#### TREATMENT OF WATER:

As the source of water is from the river Hooghly, there is considerable pollution load from physical, chemical and bacterial point of view. The range of turbidity and salinity varies very widely. During summer there is serious problem of excessive salinity whereas in

the rainy season the problem of heavy turbidity occurs. The usual process of treatment is being applied and will be introduced by way of

 Primary settling. (2) Flocculation-Coagulation. (3) Sedimentation. (4) Filtration (slow or rapid sand) (5) Disinfection (chlorination). & (6) Clear water storage.

#### CONVEYANCE OF WATER:

For better control and equitable distribution of water, eastern bank areas have been divided into three service districts: (i) Pulta Service District (ii) Calcutta Service District and (iii) Garden Reach Service District.

On the western bank two service districts are contemplated, i.e. (i) Serampore Service District and (ii) Howrah Service District.

#### 8. TOTAL WATER EXTRACTION

The Association of Engineers has now completed fifty years of existence. It is now no longer young and may be said to be growing old. On the occasion of its Golden Jubilee it is now, as it were, rising out of a stupor of seeming stagnation to an enlivenment with new vigour under the influence, of ardent enthusiasm of the rising generation of dedicated young engineers.

The problems we have before us are great. Uppermost in our minds is anxiety regarding the future career of the large number of unemployed youth, who have been educated and trained for service in the Engineering How to find employment for profession. them? It is no fault of the youth that they are not employed. It is not that they have not the requisite training, education and ability for any job. It is not correct to say that they have been trained for jobs and services that are not required here. There is a vast amount of work that is yet to be done for the welfare of the public and for which these trained youth are eminently suited. But it is by some misfortune that there is no authority to take these much wanted works on hand. The plans are in abeyance for want of funds. The funds themselves are not in the right hands. Something must be done to secure them in good time. It is to be hoped that the control that is likely to be obtained by Government through the Nationalisation of Banks will provide some solution to the problems that have arisen.

If we take a detailed look at the basic requirements of the population of this country we will find the amount of work and the employment possibilities in the need for production of:

- 11) Fertilisers & factories, improvement of of agricultural produce.
- 12) Sewage treatment plants for disposal of waste water.
- 13) Ship building yards for production of ships for transport of passengers, goods and for defence of our coasts.
  - Dry docks for repair of old craft.
- 25) Wet docks and harbours for shipment & discharge of goods.
- 16) Aircraft and landing & take off runways for Air traffic.

Pharmaceutical works.

Technical Libraries, Technical Journals 19) & Press.

Technical societies, civil, mechanical, electrical public health, telecommunication

When we consider our basic daily needs, starting from the morning, as we wake to the time we go to bed we see the enormous amount of work and and services we depend on:

- 1) The water for our abulutions before we hegin our meals and the water we drink are supplied and purified by the Municipal engineers & Waterworks.
- 2) The food that we eat is provided by dairy workers, farmers, agriculturers, fishermen, food preservers and containers & container makers, Fertiliser Factory Workers, Designers, cooks, cooking ranges, stoves, coal & coalminers,.
- 3) For disposal of sewage and refuse we depend upon Municipal sanitary services, including scavengers, garbage removers, motor vehicle drivers, pumping machinery, workers, engineers & designers.
- 4) For our transport to and from one localities of employment, profession or business, we depend on transport workers, transport drivers, operators, vehicles, their facturers, and designers, locomotive, automo-

- 5) For our habitation we depend on the housebuilder, mason, brickfield worker, architect & contractor, furniture makers, dealers, designers, timber workers, joiners, plastic & board makers.
  - For our health we require, medicines, Vitamins, etc. produced by pharmaceutical works, surgical and dental tool manufacturers.
  - 7) For our edification and knowledge we require, information by newspapers, magazines, books and radio, involving work for writers, printers artists, paper makers, printing press workers, Blockmakers, book binders, dealers & distributors, radio manufacturers, printer, press designers and manufacturers.

Without further enlarging the best of our numerous requirements, it is apparent from just these few items what a large amount of employment possibility there is for engineering workers and how much this increases with increasing population, if every body's requirement is to be met. 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


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# CIVIL ENGINEERING DESIGNS BY MAN COMPUTER DIALOGUE

#### Introduction

During the past several years, there has been tremendous advancement in the technology of high speed digital computers. The capabilities of these giant machines are being used for a variety of services other than mere computational work. One of the comparatively recent developments that has immense potential for applications is what is commonly known as Computer Graphics'.

In a broad sense, 'Computer 'Graphics' means drawing of pictures by means of computers. This includes automatic drafting, computer generated movies, animated cartoons, input-output display on cathoderay tube, and so on. This last feature has aftracted the interest of scientists and engineers, who believe that within a few years, a major part of the total computer time will be expended for graphical display. In this paper, the term 'computer graphics' is used in the limited sense of such cathode ray tube I/0 displays.

There has already been quite a few applications of computer graphics in design engineering particularly in the aero-space industry for similation of dynamic behaviour of systems. It is possible to use the same techniques to set up a general civil engineering design system.

#### Background

Digital computers are widely being used in

design engineering all over the world in recent years. Basic procedure of engineering design is to choose certain parameters of the system under study and after looking at the response, to alter them for possible optimisation of the final design. These steps are identical for structural systems, traffic systems, water or sewer systems, and possibly other branches of civil engineering. This method of repetative iteration can very efficiently be performed by modern digital computers at a tremendously fast rate, producing error-free results.

In spite of such possible high speed and accuracy of computeraided methods, optimisation of engineering systems is hardly attempted in design offices. On the successful completion of an analysis of a system by computer, the design engineer obtains a print out of several Although time is saved in thousand lines. executing this process, since the computations are made by machine, the designer does not get any feeling about the behaviour of the system unless he actually goes through those thousands of printed lines in details. Consequently, in practice, the engineer tries only a few iterations by altering the design parameters manually to obtain the final design. The immense capabilities of the machine remain unused. On the other hand, engineers accustomed to looking at the input data and the final results only, usually take more time to learn the behaviour of systems than he would take if this was done by hand-computation. This again sometimes leads to serious mistakes due to errors in the input data, which an inexperienced designer may not be able to discover by looking at the printed output.

The drawbacks of computer-aided design methods can be eliminated and at the same time the advantages of high speed and accuracy can be attained if there is a method of direct manmachines communication with the capability of displaying the input and output in a convenient form. This can be achieved, with the present state of the art, by proper use of computer graphics, the display system being equipped for direct conversational mode of operation.

Using this set up, the designer can have a visual presentation of the system under study, generated from input data. If there is any error in the input, it can be recognized instantly. Any response of the system that can be formulated mathematically, can be superimposed on the display. Any component of the system can be altered eliminated or added by means of the conversational mode of operation and the modified response of the system be displayed. The whole operation is fast, quick and effortless.

Computer graphical techniques gives two important services to the design engineers:

- (1) The designer is able to vary the parameters of the system under study almost indefinitely, and thus, by trial, he is able to select an optimal system, which may depend on so many different factors like aesthetics, interference with other systems, capacity, convenience, etc.
- (2) Since the engineer actually visualizes how the systems behave under different conditions and with different combinations of the design parameters, he becomes greately experienced in a short time. Intuitions or judgement based on experience, thus plays an important role in the design process. This is a very significant factor because most engineering designs require the values of certain parameters of the system be assumed and the more correct these

assumptions are, the faster and economic is the design.

A research programme has been conducted by the author at the department of Civil Engineering, University of Pennsylvania, for study ing the possible application of computer graphics to a general civil engineering design system. It has been established that such a unified computer graphical programme for general civil engineering design (including structural mechanics, transportation engineering. water resources engineering etc.) is perfectly feasible. In fact, this research work included actual solutions of simple design problems in structural mechanics and transportation engineering. The work is being continued with an aim to perform full-scale designs within the coming year.


#### General Approach.

The complete process of analysis, design, optimization and I/O display of a system can be performed in eight systematic steps, each of which is essentially a programming routines. These eight routines are:

- (1) Analysis Routine: for mathematical analysis of the system under consideration.
- (2) Member Properties: for computing the member properties required in the computations from the input data.
- (3) Member Design: Programme for design of members in the system on the basis of the result of analysis, satisfying the requirements of the code of practice.
- (4) Iteration Routine: This programme takes the member properties from the latest design and feed them as the new input.
- (5) Optimization Routine: The quantity to be optimised (weight, cost, etc) is computed after each iteration, stored and compared to pick up the optimal design. (Optimisation

means minimization of cost, weight etc.

incorporate the different branches in a unified computer graphical system.



- (6) On-line Access: This enables the designer to alter any parameter of the design directly by means of teletype or light pen.
- (7) Input Data: This may be in the from of punched card, punched tape or be typed on a teletype.
- (8) General Programme: Programme for input and output (I/0) display.

It has already been mentioned that the operations in the design of the different branches of Civil Engineering systems are almost identical. This enables and engineer to

#### General Operation Sytsem:

The eight essential steps of the design process are performed in a unified General Operation System. The system is schematically shown in Figure. It basically consists of a PDP-8 computer with DEC-338 display device with input-output devices like teletype, cathoderay tube, lightpen, pushbutton. etc. and as RCA Spectra 70/46 computer with X-Y plotter. For very small systems, the small computer PDP-8 may be adequate.

Input through punched card is processed by Spectra 70/46 and the output is sent to DEC 338 via PDP-8, which in turn displays them on

the cathode ray tube. Light pen, pushbuttons and teletypes are used for modification in input or output and for instructing the machine during conversational operation.

The design routines are kept in the library. for operation porgramme. The final design can be obtained as a hard-copy by means of the X-Y plotter.

#### Conclusion:

It is the opinion of experts that computer graphics may just be the beginning of a new generation of design engineering and with the results obtained, the another is inclined to believe so. With the present stage-of-the art, the designer can sit in front of a graphic display console and feed the input by a teletype. If he is a structural engineer, for example he can display a large 2 or 3 dimensional frame and by the flip of a switch, he can superimpose bending moment, or shear force diagrams. He can alter the geometry, arrangement of members,

members properties; he can add or delete any blow up any particular part of the loading zooming, and so on. All these operations are

In the future, all design engineers may be working on computer graphical systems in a number of offices, and the cost of equipments need not be too high, if produced in mass scale medium of instruction. Man and machine, working together in a graphical dialogue, will increase the efficiency of man to a great magnitude.



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


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#### SANITATION STATUS IN CALCUTTA METROPOLITAN DISTRICT

#### 1. Introduction

The vast and complex array of problems are not only engulfing the city proper but also the Metropolitan District. Calcutta Metropolitan District (CMD) covers an area of about 490 square miles (Figure-1) stretching north soutin over a length of 50 miles along the river Amongst its very many problems 'Santination' caused a stir not only within this country but also it raised a furore in the whole of the world. The reason being CMD was considered to be the nucleus of endemic cholera. In view of that a W. H. O. Consultant Team headed by Prof. Wolman made series of recommendations for the improvement of environmental sanitary conditions of CMD. Accordingly a Master Plan for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage was drawn up for CMD and presented under W. H. O. Project India-170 in 1967.

Santination though covers a very wide field, the discussion in this paper is kept limited to the collection and disposal of human excreta only.

#### 2. Existing Facilities


Within the C. M. D., sewerage systems are in operation in Kalyani, Bhatpara, Titagarh, Calcutta and Serampore. Sewerage works are under construction in Dum Dum and Manicktala. In addition to the above there are a number of tiny sewerage networks and disposal facilities serving private organisations, industrial and housing developments, institutions and factories which are really insignificant in rela-

tion to overall need. All the sewerage systems are skeleton in nature excepting those in Kalyani and Calcutta. Even in the city of Calcutta there are considerable number of unsewered pockets wherein about 40,000 service privies still exist. In the remaining municipalities and urban areas service privies are in existence (Table-I) and human excreta are collected manually with the help of buckets, carts, tankers, trailors etc. and are disposed off mainly by trenching and composting.

The remaining 16,580 nos. of service privies are scattered over the different non-municipal urban areas in the entire Metropolitan District.

#### 3. Need for Improvements:

The prevalent practice of handling and disposing of night soil is not only unhygienic but undesirable too from aesthetic and humanitarian point of view.

This is an unique source for the spread of communicable diseases like cholera, diarrhoea, dysentery, gastroenterities. typhoid, round worm and jaundies etc. Thus effective and proper disposal of human excreta is essential for promoting environmental sanitation so as to prevent infections transmitted through water, soil and flies. In addition, this prevalent system runs the risk of occasional collapse caused by labour unrest and interrupted service of the sweepers and scavengers.

#### 4. Proposed Scheme:

Sewering the entire district definitely is a wholesome and permanent solution. This involves not only a large capital outlay but also

the execution will take quite a number of years for the funds to be available. Moreover, the National Committee for the Gandhi Centenary Celebrations has called upon all local authorities and State Governments to launch a vigorous campaign for the eradication of the evils of service latrines throughout the country by 2nd October, 1969.

In view of that schemes are to be drawn up for "Conversion of Service Privy into Sanitary Latrine" as an interim measure, pending implementation of the complete sewerage scheme.

The scheme envisages construction of centrally located septic tanks (Figure 2) to which the converted sanitary latrines will be connected. Two chambered tanks are recommended with the idea of using one compartment while cleaning the other. The septic tank effluents need further treatment. Seepage or soak pits are proved to be a failure at places when the water table is high. Dispersion although is a preferable solution but is handicapped by scarcity. As such septic tanks are located very near to the municipal drains and to avoid land acquisition difficulties, septic tanks are located under the municipal roads.

#### 6. Cot Estimate:

from the pilot study over a bustee area of 2,0 acres (Figure-2). Cost includes (i) Conversion of service privy into sanitary latrine, (ii) Construction of septic tanks for treatment of human exceeta and (iii) Laying of sewer for conveyance of the waste to septic tanks.

In this bustee the population density is around 200 persons per acre. Usual population density in the old bustees varies from 300-400 persons per acre. In that case the per capita cost would automatically come down.

The facilities at least cost Ralf the cost of complete sewerage works, if not less.

#### 7. Conclusion:

this paper. The idea is to furnish before the readers a picture of sanitation standard in the biggest city of this country. Suggestion are also made for effection and disposal of human excreta. This semi-permanent method is welcoming especially from the point of view of economy. The cost is at least 50% less than the complete sewerage works. The maintenance cost is very very low compared to any method of sewage or night soil treatment.
